# ON LOVE, LIFE AND THE FUTURE

As I sit in the California sunshine after a visit with my nephew, his wife (from Vienna) and my great niece and nephew 2 ½ yrs. and 4 months respectively, I muse on the future these children will have; how connected will they be to their Southeast Asian roots? Their grandparents are the last generation connected to the old country, their parents are a generation removed and they are 2 generations removed?

Is it their responsibility to stay connected or is it our responsibility as their parents to set up a system that will allow them to feel connected to their roots? I believe it is the latter. And in order to achieve this we in this generation need to move forward and look forward instead of getting stuck in and caught into our old ways of thinking and viewing the world.

I remember as a little girl growing up in Pennsylvania, where my father was a physics professor back in the 70s a young man who had come to America to study, fell in love with an American woman. Immediately the parents in India would be upset, agitated and potential heart attacks as well as removal from the family was possible consequences if this marriage would occur. My father would be asked to intervene with the family back home. However, in this generation it is so acceptable to have marriages and relationships across cultures either internally amongst Southeast Asian members or between Southeast Asians and the larger community. How you may ask does this relate to our children's and grandchildren's futures?

### **STOP GRANT PROGRAM UPDATE**

MaiFS's Year-6 STOP Grant Empowerment program with an increased focus on counseling and life-skills advocacy sessions is up and running! The program helps South Asian DV victims and survivors in Metro Detroit area to lead empowered, productive, and fulfilling lives.

Currently, DV victims and survivors eligible to receive STOP Grant services from two large South Asian organizations, the American Chinese Association, the Bangladeshi American Public Affairs Committee (BAPAC), are participating in weekly DV Advocacy/Counseling and life-skills learning sessions. Additional DV clients from MaiFS will also start receiving these sessions effective next month.


