Every year, all ticket proceeds go toward the Mai Family Services, which provides intervention and prevention support for individuals in abusive and violent situations.



## **OUTREACH & COLLABORATION INITIATIVES**

### <u>Detroit VA, Detroit Hospital - OUTREACH</u>

Representative - Nasreen Meah, MaiFS Board of Director

To continue its mission to advocate for the needs of South Asian communities, MaiFS is currently exploring collaborating in the Intimate Partner Violence Assistance Program (IPVAP) at the VA hospital in Detroit. Our initial meeting took place last week and offered some promising options for collaboration.

Detroit VA is a part of Detroit hospital. They launched its IPVAP initiatives in 2019 in response to a national mandated policy established in 2016. Unfortunately, due to COVID the entire program was on pause up until recently. The coordinator of Intimate Partner Violence Assistance Program (IPVAP-A) reached out to MaiFS to provide culturally sensitive services to its VA population.

The outcome of the meeting highlighted the following two areas of possible collaboration:

- 1. MaiFS would be a resource for Detroit VA for its South Asian clients and their families. In addition, Detroit VA will distribute our information to their clients whenever they see fit.
- 2. MaiFS would partner with Det VA for their staff training on cultural sensitivity as part of their continuing education training.

Additionally, MaiFS currently in conversation to extend its collaboration to Ann Arbor VA hospital.

### <u>Detroit Friendship House, Detroit - COLLABORATION</u> Representative - Farhana Aktar, Detroit Action

MaiFS received a proposal for a collaborative effort for the Bangladeshi community in Hamtramck, MI. The collaboration is intended to empower the men and women of the community. MaiFS is excited about this partnership and is looking forward to working together and support the community needs.

## **STOP GRANT PROGRAM**

MaiFS's Year-6 STOP Grant Empowerment program with an increased focus on counseling and life-skills advocacy sessions was launched in January 2022. The program helps South Asian DV victims and survivors in Metro Detroit area to lead empowered, productive, and fulfilling lives. Program participants benefit through weekly sessions with trained DV Counselors to gain an awareness and understanding of issues surrounding domestic violence and to gain information on available community-wide support services to alleviate their DV situations. In addition, DV Advocates provide participants with life-skills sessions in the areas of English language, basic computer and financial skills, and other necessary soft-skills that can make the participants more independent and empowered.
