We're pleased to inform that the Division of Victim Services, State of Michigan has renewed the Domestic Violence (DV) Grant given to Mai Family Services for a 7th consecutive year, starting October 01, 2022!

Moving forward, the DV Grant will be referred to as the CSU (Culturally Specific Underserved)-Grant and not, the STOP Grant as referred to earlier. While the name will change, the Grant will continue to provide South Asian DV survivors with DV Advocacy/counseling, as well as education/tuition assistance and basic life-skills learning sessions to enable their empowerment.
