

Mai Family Services hosted its annual Community Leadership Townhall on Saturday, Feb 25th at the IGGF in Canton. The town hall was a stupendous success with over 25 active and dedicated organizations being represented to discuss and engage in conversations around family violence, senior issues, mental health and other growing concerns faced by the community.

The interactive session began with community leaders sharing their work, mission, and vision of their respective organizations. Mai Family Services provided an overview of the intervention and prevention programs, client stats, survivor stories and many possibilities to collaborate.
