

THE INVISIBLE CHAINS OF ABUSE

Miriam thought she'd found her soulmate in Deep. His charm was irresistible, but soon, their relationship took a dark turn. Deep's subtle manipulations escalated into full-blown gaslighting and domestic violence.

"You're imagining things," Deep would say when Miriam confronted him about his late nights. "Maybe you should see a therapist."

Gradually, Miriam's self-doubt grew. She stopped seeing friends, believing Deep's claims that they were a bad influence. Her world shrank to their apartment, where his mood swings dictated the atmosphere.

One night, after a heated argument, Deep shoved Miriam who got hurt as a result. The next day, he swore it never happened. "You must have dreamed it," he insisted, leaving Miriam questioning her own memory.

Financial control tightened the invisible chains. Deep managed their accounts, leaving Miriam dependent and trapped. When she considered leaving, fear paralyzed her. What if no one believed her? Where would she go? What happens to her immigration status?

Many abuse victims, like Miriam, stay silent due to fear, shame, or hope for change. Breaking free requires tremendous courage and support. Recognizing the signs of abuse is the first step toward reclaiming one's life and dignity.
