MaiFS's STOP Grant program has been empowering women from the Asian communities since 2016. Thanks to the yearly-renewable MDHHS grant, the STOP program has provided domestic violence victims and survivors with advocacy and victim services through classes in ESL, Computer Literacy and Job Skills Training.

Since the start of the COVID pandemic last year, our client classes have continued uninterrupted and we continue with the online model of instruction. Challenges are plenty, but instructors and students of the program are braving it well, but await return to actual classroom instruction.

As of December 2020, we have 50 Clients enrolled in the various ESL and Computer Literacy classes. We are working on adding a Financial Literacy class to our offerings starting in April 2021. While we are in the last year of the 5-year Grant and ends in October 2021, the Grant Team is working hard on the needed processes for MDHHS to renew the STOP Grant. We are very hopeful that our contributions to the underserved Asian community will continue to be recognized by the funding authorities.
