SURVIVOR CHALLENGES

Mai Family Services worked on the following challenges in 2024:

SYSTEM

- Language barriers beyond just translation (cultural context missing)
- Fear of police/authority due to immigration concerns
- Limited knowledge of available services
- Systems not understanding extended family dynamics in abuse

CULTURE

- Non-SA providers missing family honor/shame dynamics
- Religious/spiritual aspects often overlooked
- Misunderstanding of joint family abuse patterns
- Cultural gaslighting ("this is normal in our culture")
- Limited culturally-specific housing options

FINANCIAL

- Limited access to family finances/accounts
- No credit history in US
- Skills/degrees not transferring from home country
- Community pressure against employment
- Dowry-related financial abuse

IMMIGRATION

- Fear of losing children due to visa status
- Complex U visa process
- Limited work authorization options
- Abandonment in home countries
- Joint tax filing requirements with abuser



CASE STATISTICS 2024

In 2024, Mai Family Services supported 69 survivors with 32 achieving independence milestones - a 46% empowerment rate that demonstrates our program's effectiveness.

We handled 124 crisis resource calls while addressing 6 senior cases, showing our crucial role as a culturally-sensitive lifeline for the South Asian community.

Mai Family Services and the State of Michigan's Division of Victim Services is offering FREE Empowerment Programs to South-Asian community members.


Eligible participants benefit from counseling and advocacy sessions that address issues to counter individual vulnerabilities and are offered through a distinct South-Asian socio-cultural perspective.

Community organizations representing South-Asians in Oakland, Macomb, Wayne, and Washtenaw are eligibile to participate in the program. Our Empowerment Programs are offered FREE and include:

- ~ Learning and practicing English language
- ~ Enhancing life skills through computers and financial literacy sessions
- ~ Group activities and information on culturally acceptable supportive services in the community
 - Sessions held remotely through Zoom






